About the Show

This new animated TV series is a co-production between Dog Ears and Cartoon Saloon. It is a 2D, Toon Boom Production with a uniquely exciting epic tale at the heart. There's lots of action, adventure and humour throughout with a rich cinematic visual style for audiences aged 8+.

Role

We are looking for Scene Prep Artists all levels (Junior, Mid and Senior) to come and work with us on our exciting new 2D series.

Key responsibilities:

- Responsible for compiling the initial Toon Boom Harmony files for each scene from an episode to contain the most up to date scene animatic, layouts, characters and props for each scene as and when available from the design and build departments.
- To be responsible for outputting your allocated weekly quota, comprising multiple passes and approval by our Assistant Director and Director.
- To ensure quality and style of show is consistently achieved in scene prep work and that all notes/retakes are added.
- To work closely with our Assistant Director, Animation Supervisor and Animation Leads to ensure that all shots contain all assets and information necessary for the Animation and Posing teams.
- To assist with the quality control of each Harmony file before they leave the Scene Prep department (technical check) and before they go to the Animation team
- To report directly to the Assistant Director, Production Manager and Coordinator.
- To be responsible for Harmony camera moves and maintaining scene continuity.

This list is not exhaustive and might be complemented by reasonable and related tasks that are requested of you.

Key requirements:

- Be driven and able to work effectively on an independent basis;
- Fluent in English;
- Ability to communicate well in a fast-paced and creative environment;
- Must possess excellent time management skills with the utmost respect for deadlines;
- Be available on messaging systems and by emails during working hours;
- Must be based in the UK and willing to potentially relocate to Derry.
